


How can I have the search option available on my Formweb home page?

In the editor go to "Options", "Other options" and check the box "Enable sitewide search field".



Then click "Update options" and you'll have a search option in the top right corner on your Formweb home page.



How does a quick search help me?

Enabling quick search (from "Options") allows you to enter a drug search that filters directly to a drug as long as the text entered only filters to a single drug.

Formweb search filter

Currently when you perform a general search in Formweb (if you have that feature enabled), you see a list of results in order of relevance related to your searched text. With the new filter option, you will be able to select where you are looking for information. Here I entered antibiotics in the search field, and it gave me these results

When you perform a general search in Formweb you can filter where you are looking for information.

Here I entered "antibiotic" in the search field, and it gave me these results.





If I wanted to only look for one place where that text might be referenced, I can click the filter drop down button  and narrow the search to only what I am looking for.



Here I have limited the search to only drugs that have the word antibiotic somewhere in the build.
