

## How to Add a New Drug to Your Formulary

• Add the Generic Drug first, then Add the Brand Drug(s)

To add a new drug to your formulary, the generic drug must be added first. The generic is the top of the hierarchy in your FormWeb formulary.

- 1. In the Generic Name field, type the first few letters of the drug, until you see the drug in the dropdown. Select from the dropdown. This method ensures correct spelling, and any tall manlettering that may apply.
- **2.** Select a DEA Class if appropriate.

\*Note the Generic Code. This code is assigned by the software and cannot be changed. When you need it, a convenient "Display Generic Code" link is always there for you.

- 3. Click in the box where you see "Select a T-class". When you begin typing (either the therapeutic class name or number), you will see a list of choices begin to show up. Type as much as you want, but when you see what you are looking for click on it to select it. Once you have selected it, you will see it has been added to the field.
  - a. If you need to add more than one T-class, you can continue to type, and select as many as applies to the generic.
- **4.** Scroll down and click Add Generic. Add Generic You should see your Success reported to you as in this sample:
