

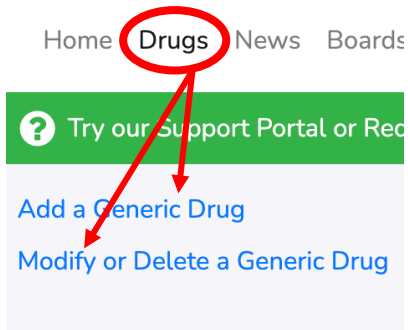
Adding Drugs to Your FormWeb Listings

Listings refer to the links on your left frame below the Search tab that contain specific categories of drugs.

Log into your editor at <http://www.formweb.com/control> and select the **Drugs** at the top of your page.

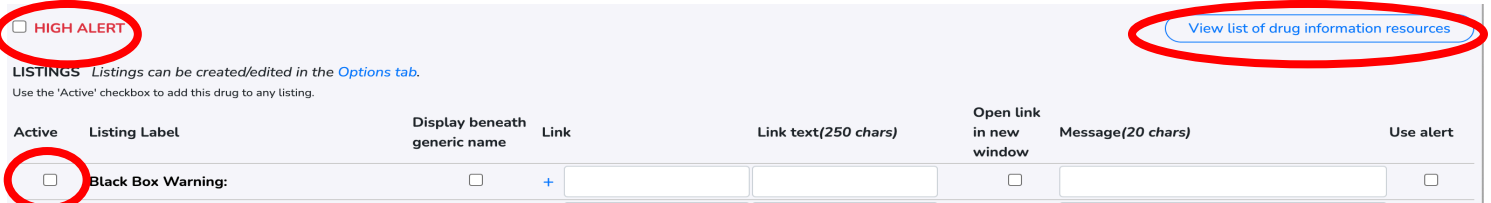
Adding a drug to any of your listings can be done when you “Add a Generic Drug” for the first time, or if the drug already exists, you can “Modify or Delete a Generic Drug” and add to the listing then.

Select the appropriate: (a) Add a Generic Drug, or (b) Modify or Delete a Generic Drug. Search for the generic name.



The drug will appear in the search results. Click **Update**.

The “High Alert” check box is for drugs that your facility or health system has placed on your “High Alert” list, and will link to a policy or document that contains specific information. (This link is managed in the “Options” section of the editor).

<p>Active: This box must be checked if you want the information to display.</p>	<p>Listing Label: This is the text that appears to the left of the hyperlink or plain text.</p>	<p>Display Beneath Generic Name: By checking this box, the “Black Box Warning” will move from the default position to directly below the generic name.</p>	<p>Link: Insert a URL to the drug found in the Black Box site: https://blackboxrx.com</p> <p>This field is not mandatory.</p> <p>Note: Click the + symbol, and you can expand to four possible Link and/or Link Text fields as shown.</p>	<p>Link Text: This text becomes the hyperlink.</p> <p>IMPT: The only requirement to put a drug into any listing is to have one or more characters in the TEXT field.</p>	<p>Open Link in New Window: A check in this box causes the link to open in a new tab or window. Good for anytime you are linking outside of Formweb.</p>	<p>Message: Text from the Message field appears next to the drug in Formweb search results or alpha lists. It does not appear in the drug detail/monograph, only in the lists mentioned.</p>	<p>Use Alert: If you want an alert pop-up box to appear when viewing the drug, check the Use Alert checkbox. The alert will be the text from the Message field</p>
