

Adding Drugs to Your FormWeb Listings

Listings refer to the links on your left frame below the Search tab that contain specific categories of drugs.

Log into your editor at http://www.formweb.com/control and select the Drugs at the top of your page.

Adding a drug to any of your listings can be done when you "*Add a Generic Drug*" for the first time, or if the drug alreadyexists, you can "*Modify or Delete a Generic Drug*" and add to the listing then.

Select the appropriate: (a) Add a Generic Drug, or (b) Modify or Delete a Generic Drug. Search for the generic name.



The drug will appear in the search results. Click Update.
