ado-trastuzumab emtansine	<a href="#">↗</a> Approx AWP \$12,000/dose
agalsidase beta	<a href="#">↗</a> Approx AWP \$18,000/dose <b>i</b> Standard of care for inpatients with Fabry; assess for appropriateness to delay therapy until outpatient
aldesleukin	<a href="#">↗</a> Approx AWP \$15,000/dose
