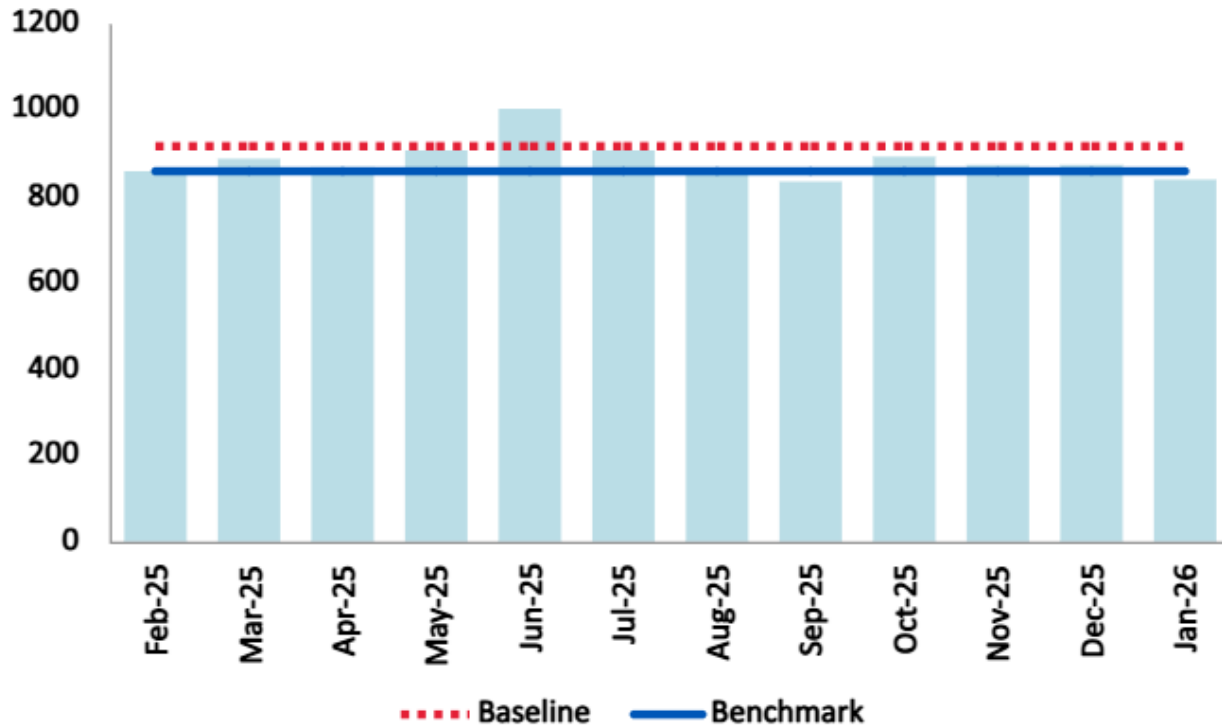

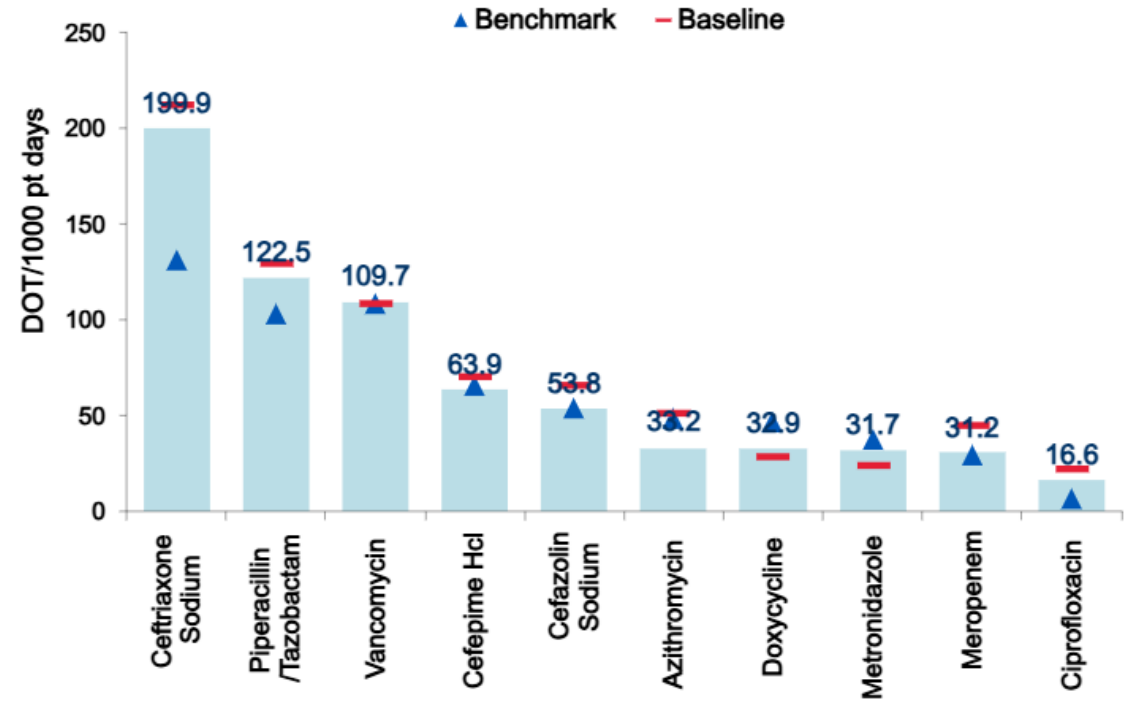

Antibiotic Total DOT/1000 pt day trend

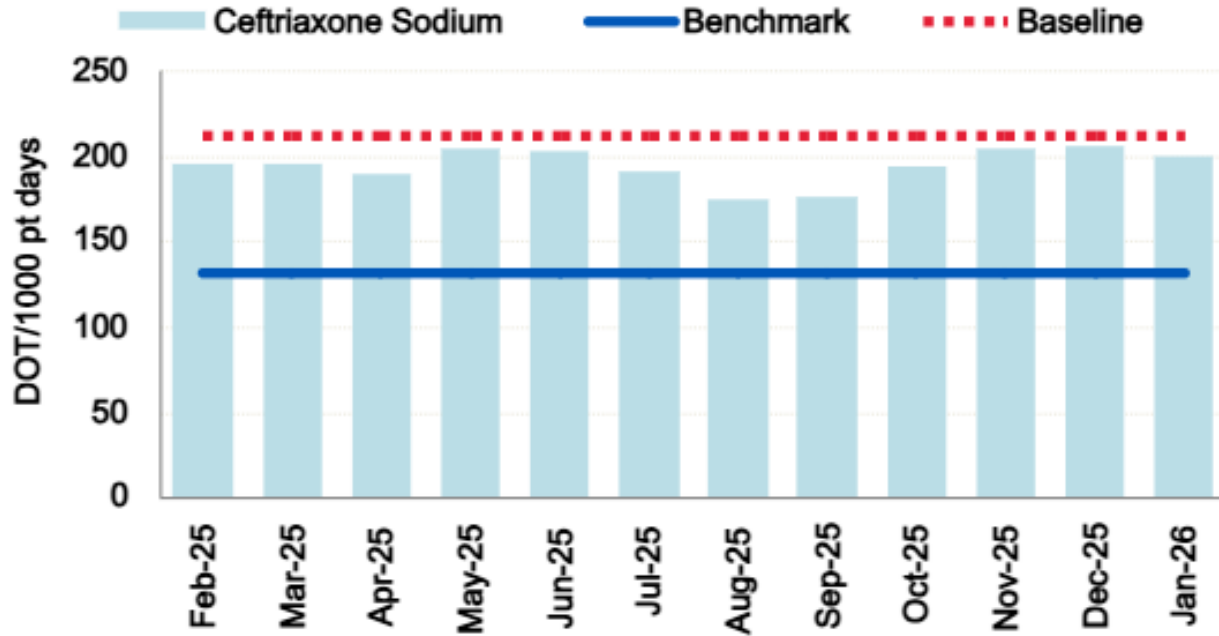


Top 10 Abx DOT vs Benchmark vs Baseline

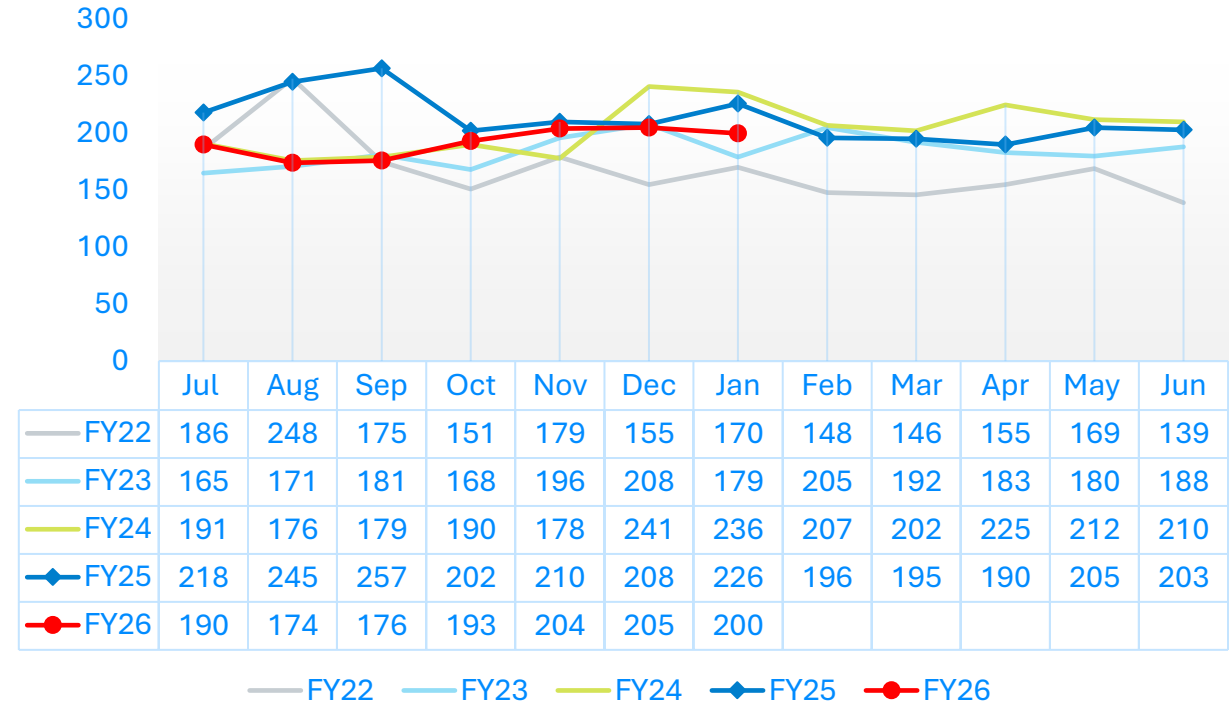

Lourdes RMC Ceftriaxone DOT/1000 pt days

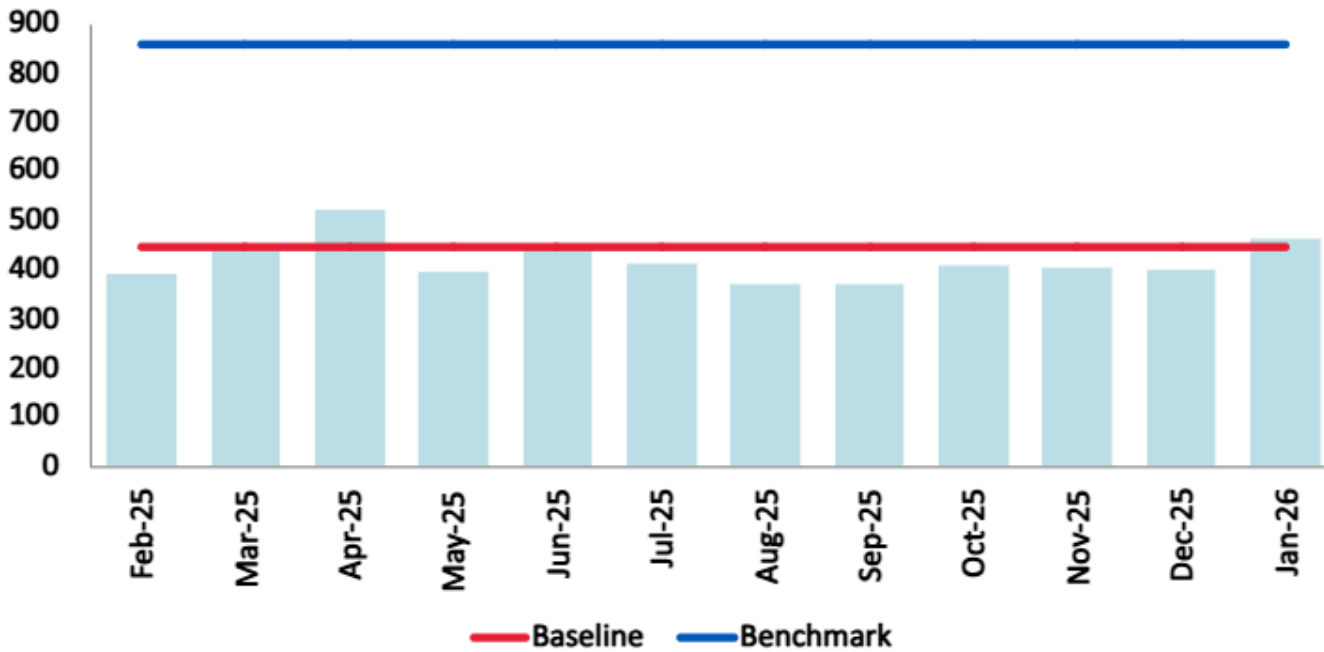

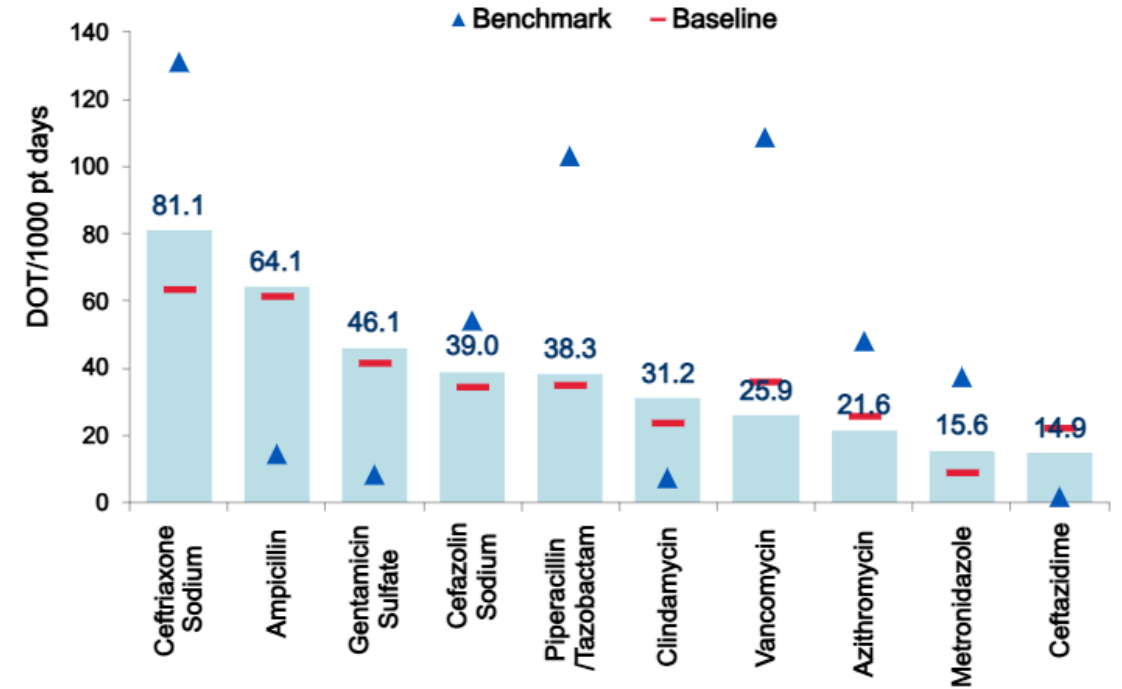


Antimicrobial Usage – LOWC (WCH) / Cardinal DCOA

Antibiotic Total DOT/1000 pt day trend

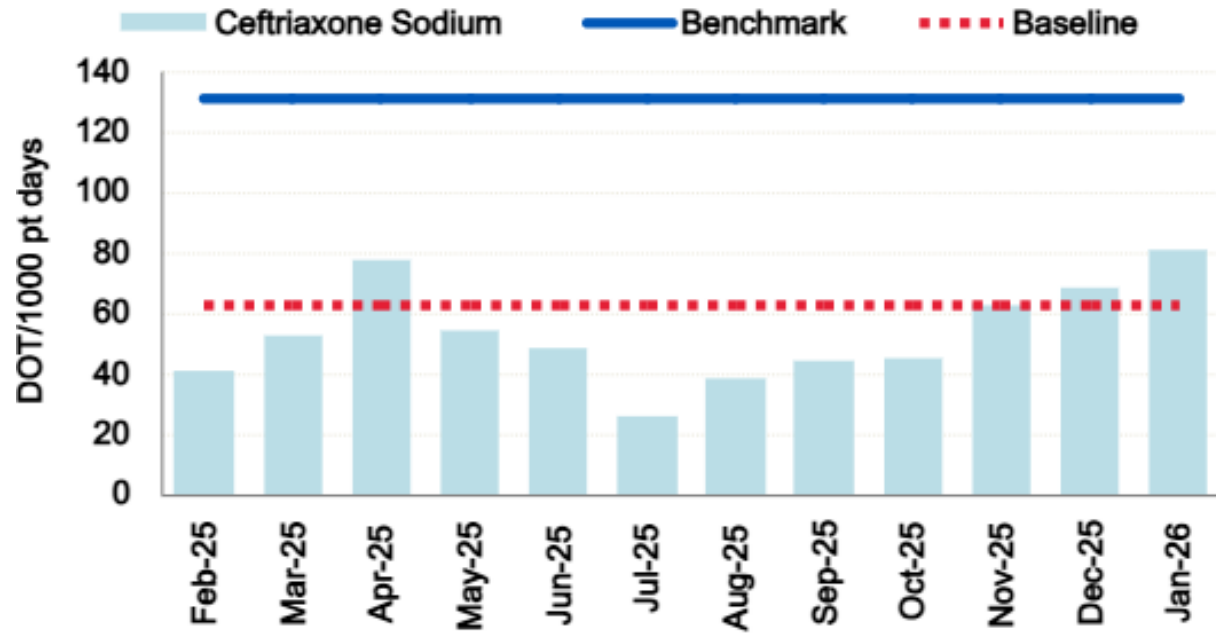


Top 10 Abx DOT vs Benchmark vs Baseline

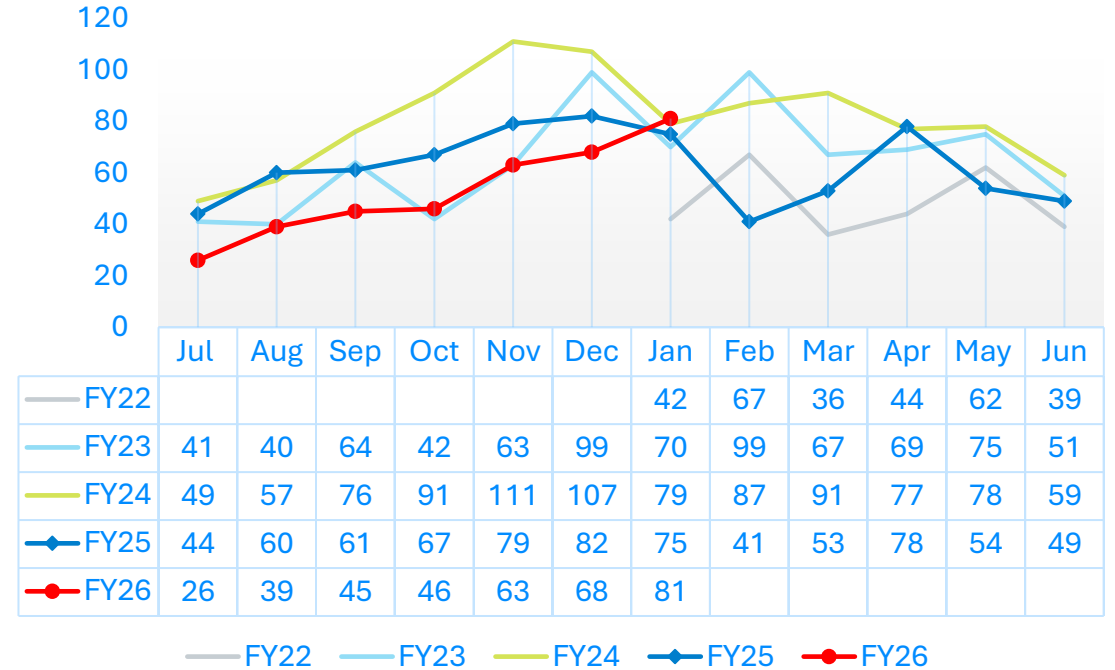


Antimicrobial Usage – LOWC (WCH) / Cardinal DCOA

Ceftriaxone Sodium

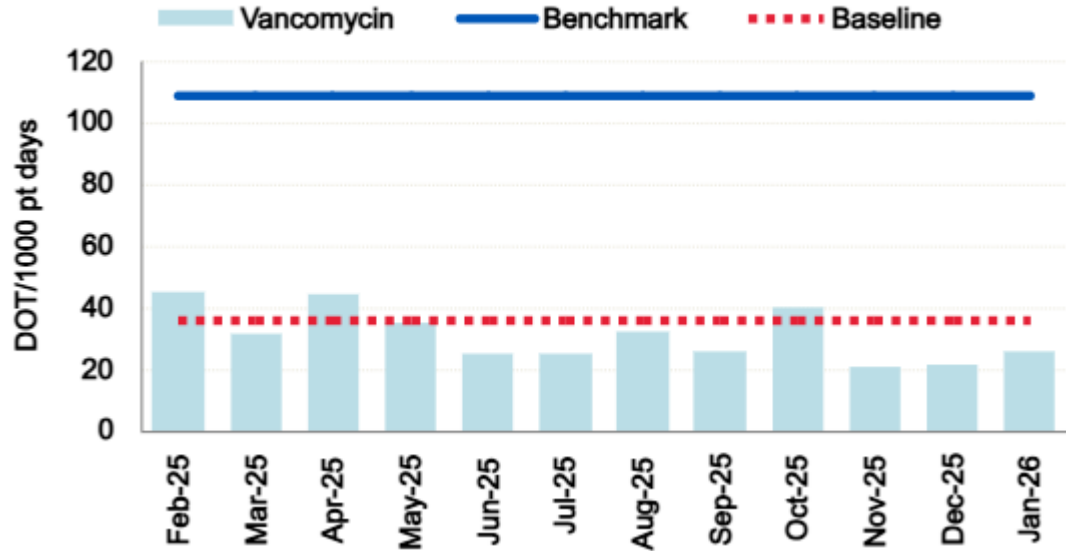


WCH Ceftriaxone DOT/1000 pt days

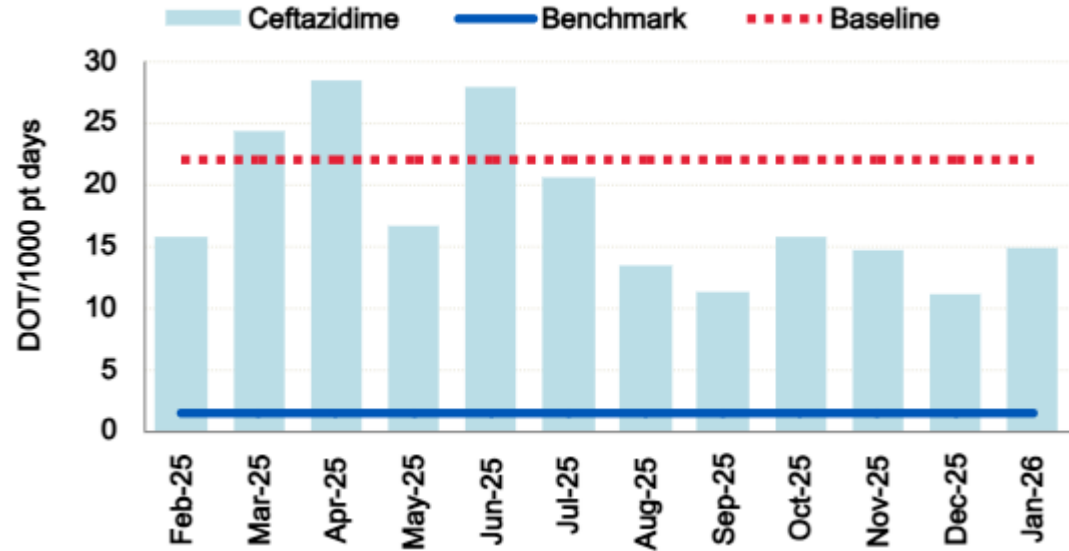

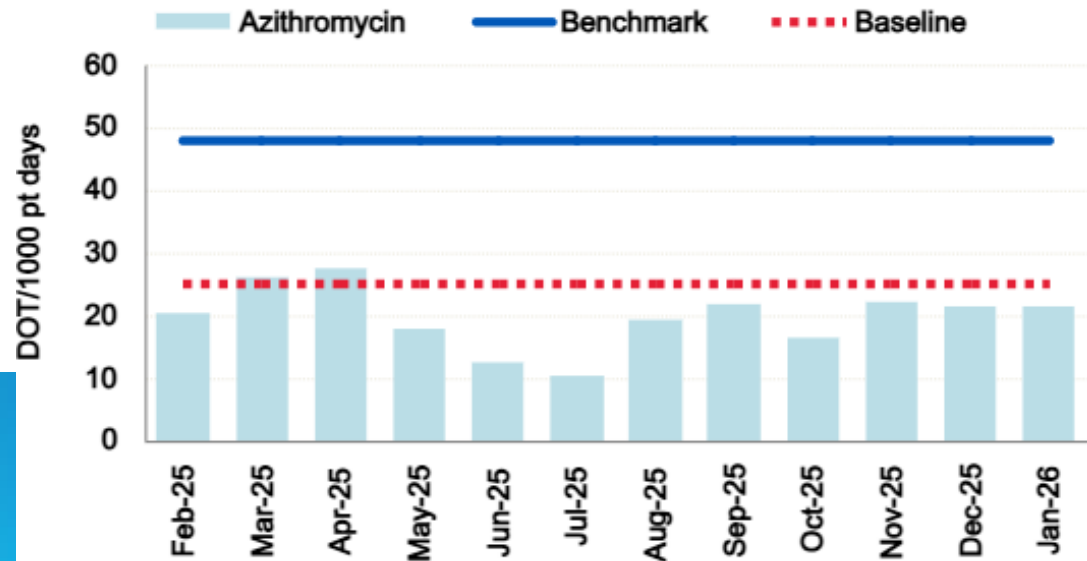

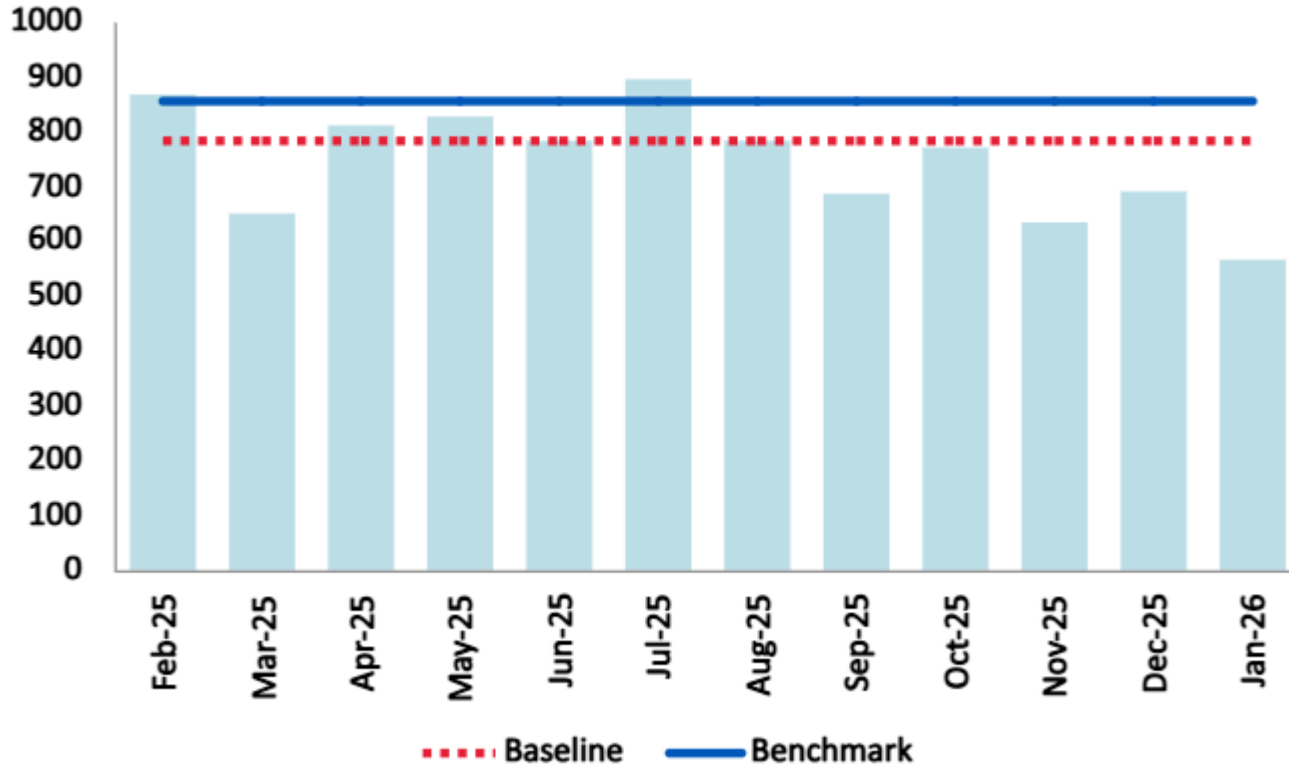

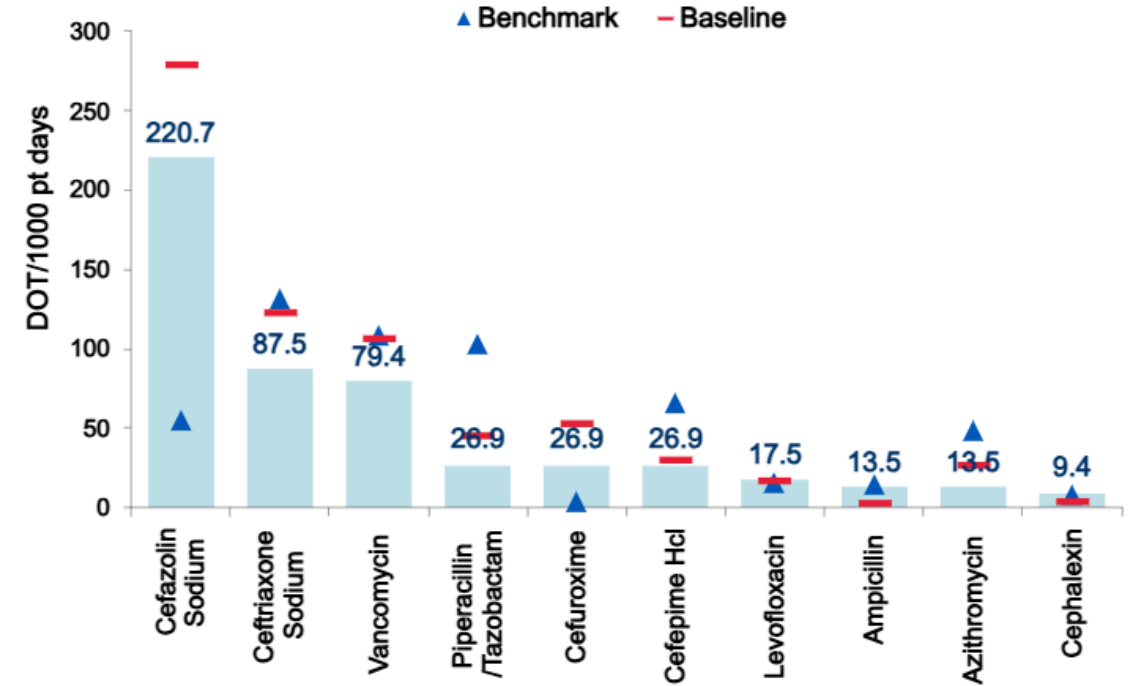

Antibiotic Total DOT/1000 pt day trend

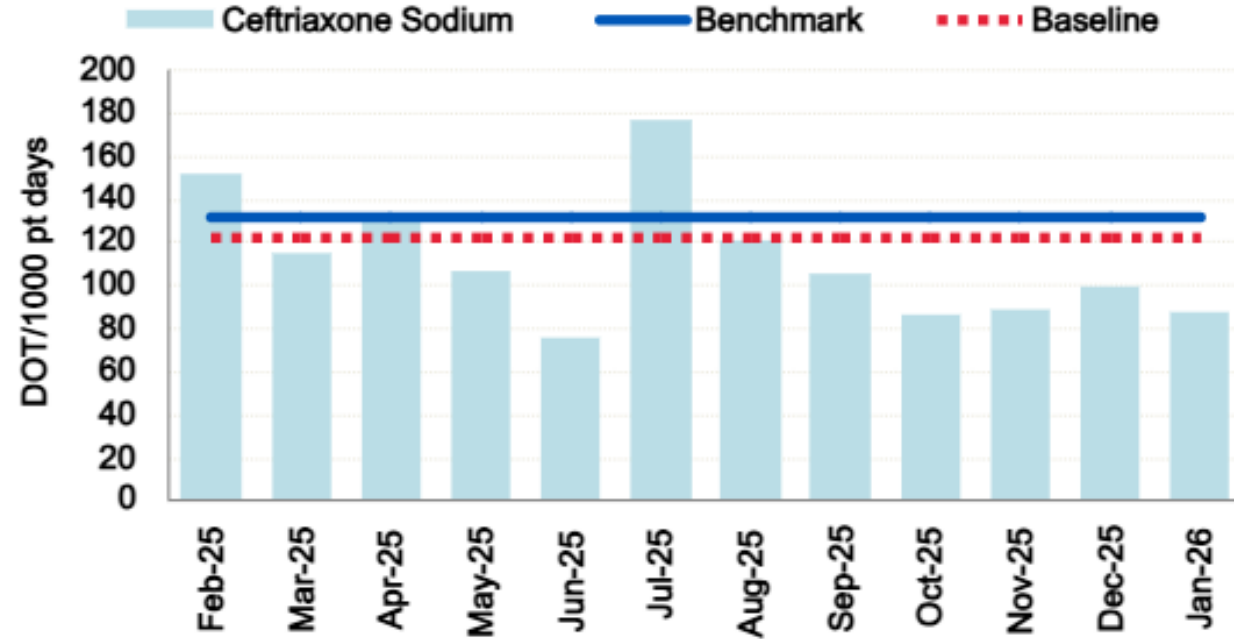


Top 10 Abx DOT vs Benchmark vs Baseline

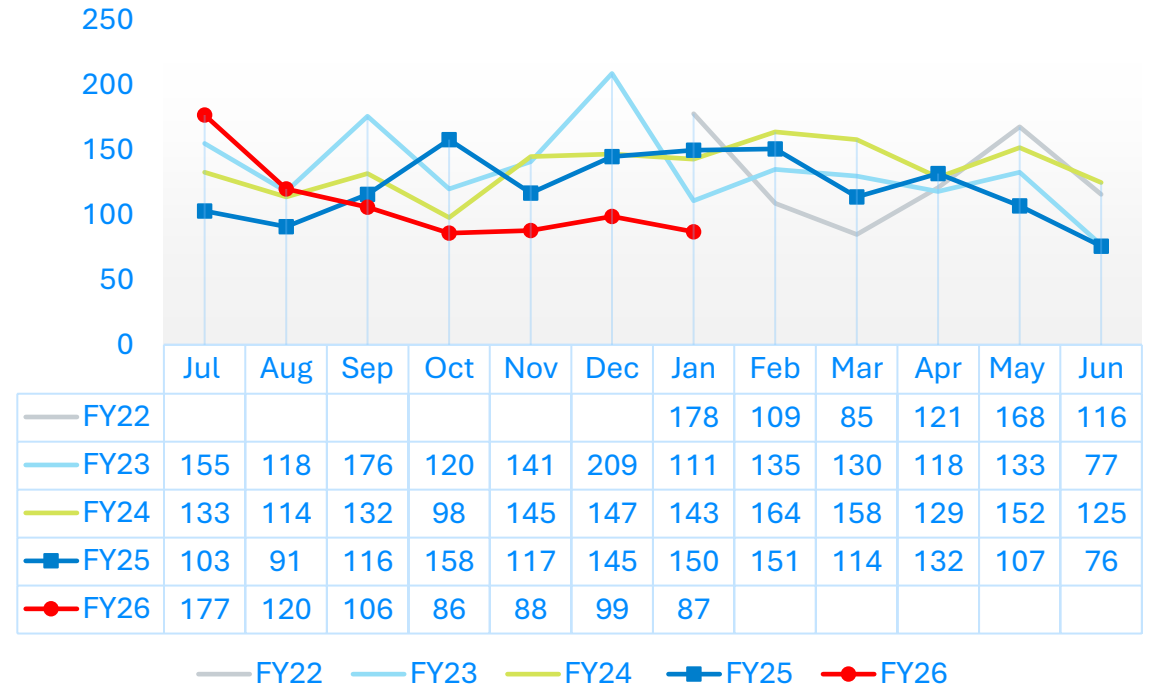

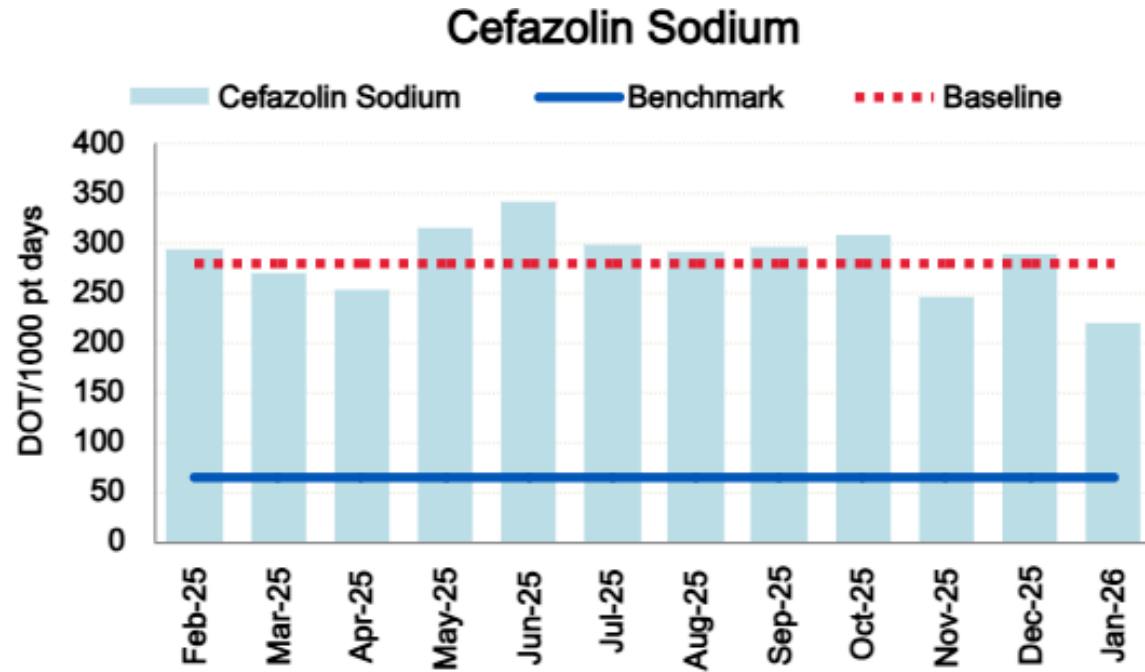

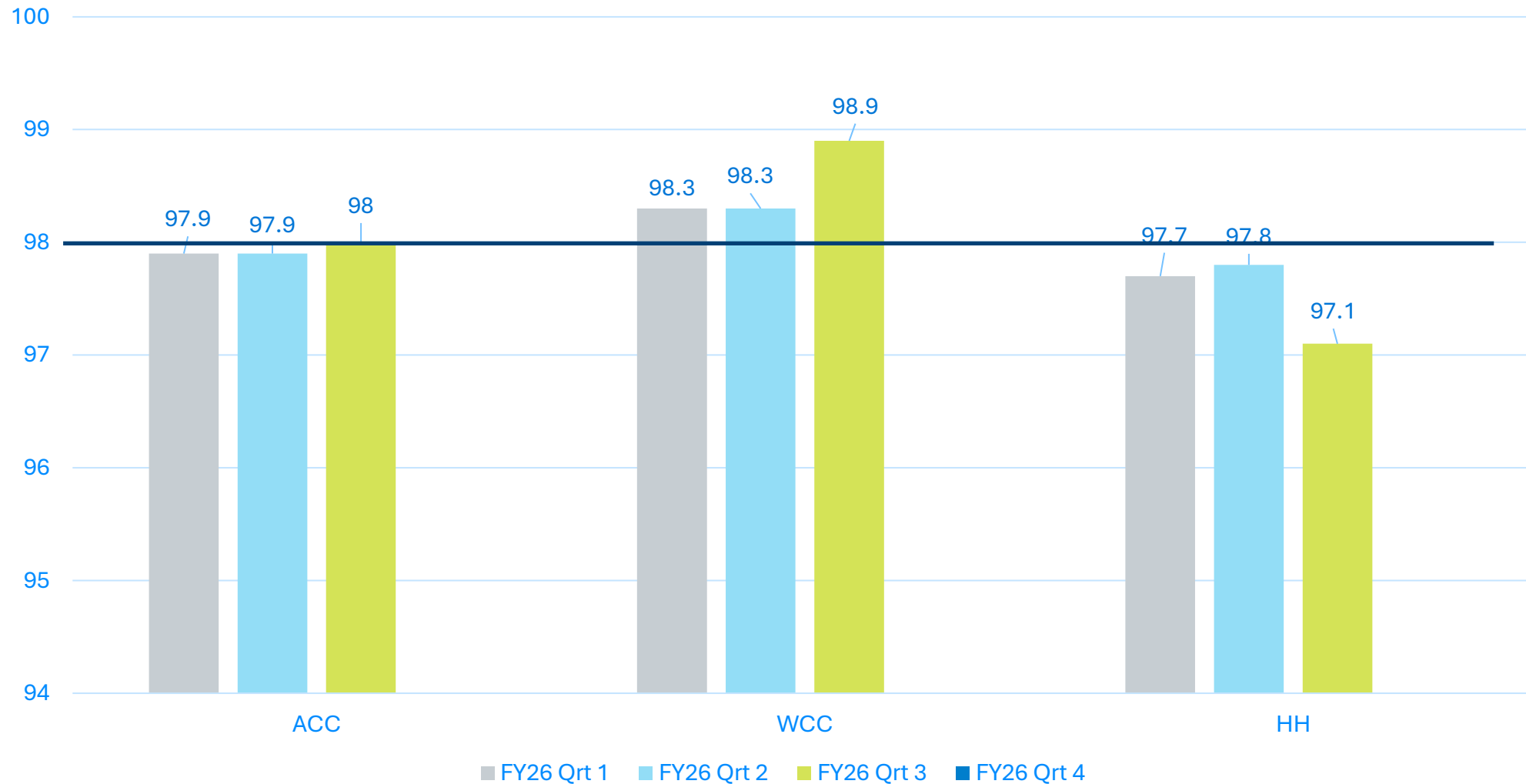
