

Rx WASTE DISPOSAL QUICK REFERENCE

Sharps

- ALL EMPTY syringes with or without needles including those used for NG tubes/feedings and ORAL syringes
- EMPTY syringes with or without needles and vials that previously contained controlled substances

Needles, ampules

"NO MEDS IN THE RED"



Hazardous Medications & Partials in a Syringe WITH or WITHOUT a Needle

- Syringes <u>with or without</u> a needle **containing any amount of NON-controlled medication** including those used for NG tubes/feedings and ORAL syringes
- Insulin (pens, syringes, vials)
- Contrast, Kcentra
- •Digoxin inj./solution, amiodarone, levothyroxine, armour thyroid, betadine, silver sulfadiazine, Neo-Synephrine, Cepastat, Chloraseptic spray, cyclosporine, multi-vitamins
- Liquid iron products, alcohol containing products (many liquid forms contain alcohol)
- Coumadin (tablet only packaging may go in the trash)
- Unused Nicotine gum/patch (packaging may go in the trash)

Non-Hazardous Medications & Partials

- **No syringes of any kind with or without a needle can go in this container**
- Any leftover/unused pharmaceutical without a message (partial vials, caps, tabs, solutions, ointments, drops, etc.)
- Partial IVPBs/IVs with additional medication added
- Insulin Drips, TPN including those with insulin, Oxytocin, Heparin

No special disposal messaging on the product or during



Incompatible/Aerosol Medications

- Aerosol Inhalers/Canisters (Ventolin,QVAR), Dermoplast, Americaine, Hurricaine, Cetacaine, Pain Ease
- Unused Silver Nitrate Sticks

All Controlled Substances (CII, CIII, CIV, CV) and PROPOFOL

DAVENPORT & SILVIS ONLY: Liquids, Injectables, Patches, Tabs and Caps in designated slots (Do not attempt to place physical syringes, needles, ampules, vials, or bottles in this container)

ALEDO & DEWITT: Liquids, Injectables, Patches, Tabs and Caps in designated slots (Do not attempt to place physical syringes, needles, ampules, vials, or bottles in this container)

Controlled substances in vials, oral syringes, or injectable syringes should be wasted into the appropriate receptacle as described above and the empty vial or syringe with or without a needle should be placed in a red sharps container.

Plain IV Fluids

- Normal Saline, Dextrose, Lactated Ringers, Potassium, Magnesium, Calcium, Sodium Bicarbonate
- · Plain fluids with no additional medication instilled

Empty Items

• Fully infused IV bags/Empty IVPBs, tubing, empty vials, medication cups, packaging, uncontaminated gloves, pads, and gowns

Bulk & Trace Chemotherapy Waste

- **BULK:** All leftover unused Chemo, IV bags, tubing, non-empty vials, any material used to clean up chemo spills, chemo hood filters
- TRACE: Empty Chemo vials, empty syringes/sharps, PPE
