Step	On 3 rd Shift, before the tech goes out to deliver the cartfill, they will stock the bottom of their cart full with	
1	10 ml & 3 ml Flushes.	
2	As they are making their rounds with the cartfill, they will check each floors designated area of Flushes to make sure they are fully stocked. The Tower floors 7, 6 & 5, stock their flushes on the top shelf above the sink. 4 South – In the drawer below the In/Out bin & the top shelf above the In/Out bins. 4 North – The top 2 shelves above the In/Out bins. ICU – Bottom left shelf under the SPD supplies. CIU 1 – There are two drawers under the fridge that are marked accordingly. CIU 2 – There are 2 drawers under the computer next to the fridge that are marked accordingly.	
3	Each floor gets 4 boxes of 10 ml & 4 boxes of 3 ml Flushes. With the exception of ICU, they get 6 boxes of 10 ml & 4 boxes of 3 ml.	
4	If a floor is below that quantity, ONLY leave them enough to bring them back up to PAR. Do not leave any extra.	
5	During a time of short supply on Flushes, do your best to distribute them evenly throughout the floors.	
6	This is to be done EVERY night while delivering the cartfill.
