Illumicare Ribbon Controlled Substances and NaRxScore Storyboard Integration Updates

## **Epic PMP Report – Pharmacy Access**

National Provider Identification (NPI) Number Requirement

 To access the PMP report through Epic, an NPI number must be associated with the individual's Texas PMP user profile

- Individuals may register for an NPI number through the National Plan & Provider Enumeration System website at <a href="https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/#/">https://nppes.cms.hhs.gov/#/</a>
  - Additional instructions for updating your Epic user profile and Texas PMP account will be provided by your management team



#### NaRx Score Storyboard link

- EHR integration via patient Storyboard
- No log-in required
- Automatic report generation within Epic (no separate window
- Prescription report limited to Texas and surrounding states

#### Texas PMP AWARxE Website

- Requires separate browser outside of EHR
- Separate log-in
- Custom entry of patient specific information (manual entry)
- Include additional states if needed
- Update your profile

#### Illumicare Smart Ribbon – Controlled Substances Button

- EHR integration via Illumicare SmartRibbon
- PIN-based log-in
- Automatically imports patient information
- Prescription report limited to Texas and surrounding states unless all states defaulted in PMP profile




#### PDMP and Medication List Discrepancies

- NaRx Score 000 ≠ 0 prescriptions
- If controlled substance are on patient's medication list but no prescription report found in Epic report:
  - Prescriptions filled out of state
  - Patient name or DOB reported on Texas PMP website may be different from chart
  - Multiple patient profiles listed on Texas PMP website
- Solution: Confirm information on actual Texas PMP website

#### Methadone for OUD Review

#### System\_RXCLIN 170 Procedure for Obtaining & Reviewing Medication History

- A. Oral Methadone Orders Review
  - a. Complete a medication history following steps A-H above if not previously completed on the same admission
  - b. If a methadone order is identified, Prior to verification of oral methadone orders, a PDMP review will be conducted by the pharmacist.
  - c. If information regarding oral methadone use is not available through the PDMP or medication dispense history because the prescribing location is an Opioid Treatment Program, escalate the review to the clinical pharmacist.
  - d. Order verification pharmacist will open an i-Vent
    - . Type: Communication to Clinical Specialist
    - ii. Subtype: Methadone
    - iii. Status: Open
  - e. Clinical pharmacist will attempt to verify the methadone dose with patient's outpatient Opioid Treatment Program. NOTE: these facilities have limited operational hours (e.g. mornings during the week and are closed on weekends)
    - i. Determine the methadone clinic used by the patient for their OUD
    - ii. Identify the methadone indication, dose, frequency, last dose taken, and quantity supplied by outpatient treatment program.
    - iii. If unable to contact the facility and if available, a patient's medication bottle may be used to verify the needed information. Note the last filled date to ensure current prescription.
  - f. If the patient's home dose cannot be confirmed, do NOT verify the order. A lower dose (no more than 20 mg) may be administered until patient's home dose can be verified. An updated order must be obtained from the authorizing provider.
  - g. Assess relevant drug interactions, laboratory values, and QTc monitoring.
    - Methadone is a major CYP3A4 and CYP2B6 substrate
    - ii. Baseline ECG (evaluate QTc interval) is recommended in certain patient populations and with use of high doses (ie, >120 mg). Repeat ECG should be repeated 2 to 4 weeks after initiating therapy, after significant dose increases, and with new risk factors or signs/symptoms of arrhythmia occur.
