### **Purpose**

Order entry and verification of medication orders may be provided by Iredell Memorial Hospital's Central Pharmacy by means of Remote Order Entry (ROE) using remote connection to Iredell Davis Behavioral Health's Electronic Medical Record (EMR).

### **Policy**

ROE shall be performed by Central Pharmacy during the time at which the Iredell Davis Pharmacy is closed or as requested.

Iredell Davis will provide pharmacists with secure, HIPPA compliant electronic access to all Iredell Davis clinical systems necessary to review medication orders.

A licensed pharmacist employed by Iredell Health System will review, verify and approve each medication order as per *Medication Ordering and Processing Policy*.

At the beginning and end of each ROE coverage period, a pharmacist shall provide proper hand off of any appropriate or necessary information.

ROE Pharmacist(s) shall be available to provide information to healthcare personnel as needed and shall maintain open communication with healthcare personnel for any medication order changes.

Iredell Health System shall ensure there is a pharmacist available in the event access to Iredell Davis needs a specific medication not stocked in an Automated Dispensing Cabinet.
