	<u>Severe infections</u> (PNA, complicated UTI, pyelonephritis) 750 mg q24h	20-49	750 mg q48h
		< 20/HD	750 mg x1, then 500 mg q48h (after HD)
		CRRT	750 mg x1, then 500 mg q24h
